# Credit Recovery and Advanced Course Summer Options

Edgenuity virtual summer courses run from early June to late August. Scholars entering 10th and 11th grades in the fall who have failed a core subject course for the semester or the year may take a credit recovery course to earn the credit. Core subject credit recovery courses will take approximately 40 hours to complete per semester. Advanced math scholars entering 9th grade in the fall may take Algebra 1. If they pass Algebra 1, they will take Geometry in the fall. Scholars entering 10th grade in the fall may take Geometry. If they pass Geometry, they will take Algebra 2 in the fall. Advanced credit courses will require approximately 50 hours per semester. Scholars may only take one advanced math credit class over the summer in high school. Scholars are required to have a “A” in the same subject course and teacher recommendation. Please contact Ms. Flitz with any summer school questions - kari.flitz@tlabeloit.com.

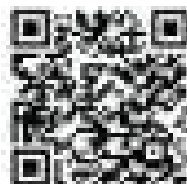
